

POLICY REVIEW AND EVALUATION/MANUAL ACCURACY CHECK

The board of education shall maintain its policies up-to-date so that they may be used consistently as a basis for Board action and administrative decision. The Board and the superintendent of schools will review board policies on a continuing basis.

The board will evaluate how the policies have been executed by the school staff and determine whether the policies effectively advance the educational and operational goals and objectives of the school district. The Board may rely on the school staff, students, and the community for providing evidence of the effect of the policies it has adopted.

The superintendent will call to the Board's attention all policies that are out of date or for other reason appear to need revision.

The superintendent will recall all policy and regulations manuals periodically for purposes of administrative updating and board review.
