

VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

In the event of a vacancy occurring in the membership of the board of education, the board of education shall provide for the filling of that vacancy in one of the following ways:

- I. The board may by majority vote, appoint a person to fill the vacancy until the next annual meeting.
- II. The board may call a special meeting of the district's voters to fill the vacancy, within 90 days of the occurrence of the vacancy. In such case, the person elected shall fill the unexpired term of the person who has vacated a position.
- III. If a vacancy on the Board occurs within seven days before the deadline for filing nominating petitions for election at the next annual meeting, the Board shall fill the vacancy by appointment until the next succeeding annual meeting or special election.
