

## **ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEES AND TASK FORCES**

The Board of Education of the Berlin Central School District hereby affirms that the judgements and decisions of the Superintendent and the Board take into consideration the opinions and views of those who may be affected by such decisions, including principals, teachers, parents, and students.

The Superintendent of Schools may establish such permanent or temporary committees or task forces as s/he deems necessary for the proper administration and management of the schools, and for the improvement of the educational program.

All such committees and task forces created by the Superintendent should be for the purpose of obtaining the advice and counsel of district personnel and residents and to facilitate communication and the lively exchange of ideas within the district.

Such committees and task forces may advise the Superintendent on a wide variety of issues including: routine district operations such as negotiations, curriculum projects, district policy and regulations, as well as current projects, problems, and issues; to develop objectives for the district's schools; to conduct program evaluation, supervision and program development.

The Superintendent shall inform the Board of the establishment of any such committee or task force, including its proposed function and report periodically to the Board concerning the work of the committee or task force.

Such committees and task forces shall function exclusively in an advisory capacity and may make recommendations to the Board through the Superintendent.
