

## **FEDERAL FUNDS**

### I. Determination to Seek Federal Funds

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education shall consider whether to apply for any federal funds for which it is eligible and matching funds are required of the District. The Superintendent of Schools shall evaluate federally-funded programs, and shall determine the manner in which and the extent to which programs and activities provided with such funds would be of benefit to the children and youth of the District. The Superintendent may apply for funds that do not require additional expenditures by the District but shall inform the Board of grant programs requiring a match by the District and shall make her/his recommendation to the Board for disposition.

### II. Separate Fiscal Accounting

The District shall maintain the Special Aid Fund to record all financial transactions in federally-aided programs and activities. The District shall further maintain a separate checking account, distinct from all other accounts held by the District for the Special Aid Fund.
