

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL VEHICLES

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education establishes that all students who are transported by the District shall adhere to appropriate standards of conduct in being transported and when they are waiting to be transported on or have exited from a school vehicle. "Appropriate standards of conduct" shall mean compliance with Student Codes of Conduct of the Berlin Central School District, as well as standards of conduct as may be required specifically by the circumstances of transporting students in a safe, orderly, and efficient manner.

The Superintendent of Schools shall develop and implement such regulations as may in her/his judgment be necessary to put this policy into effect.

The Superintendent of Schools is authorized to place video cameras or simulate the appearance of the presence of a video camera on transportation vehicles owned by the District as a means of monitoring student behavior and encouraging appropriate student behavior on District vehicles. The use of such video recording devices shall be disclosed to students, parents and all passengers on District vehicles.
