

## **STUDENT DRIVING**

Student driving on school property is a privilege, not a right. Students may drive vehicles onto school property only with permission of the building principal, who will also designate parking areas and promulgate rules and regulations for their use. Only students in good standing, as determined by the building principal, may be authorized to drive to school.

The building principal is empowered to suspend these privileges.

Students are not permitted to drive a vehicle during the school day without the written permission of a parent or guardian.

Upon reasonable grounds, a student may be required to open the vehicle without the relinquishing of his/her rights under the Fourth Amendment.
