

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education recognizes the importance of maintaining an effective educational program in the District's schools. This program should reflect the instructional standards and curriculum established by the state and the interests of the educational community in the District. The Board recognizes that effective participation in on-going curriculum development is among the most important responsibilities of the District's professional staff

The Board therefore establishes that the Superintendent of Schools shall review or cause the review of the curriculum employed in the District; and also, whenever the Superintendent deems necessary, to recommend to the Board specific ways to improve the curriculum, so that that what is taught in the District's schools better incorporates sound educational research and current desirable practices.

The Superintendent shall establish and implement regulations and procedures whereby the curriculum of the Berlin Central School District is systematically reviewed and developed. The regulations and procedures so developed shall ensure that any recommendations she/he makes to the Board for changes in the curriculum will be the result of extensive consultation with staff at appropriate levels of school organization.
