

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education supports and encourages the development and operation in the District's schools of programs that challenge and promote each child's individual aptitudes and abilities.

Enrichment opportunities shall be available to the extent permitted by school district resources. Appropriate learning activities for academically talented students may be incorporated into classroom instruction at the elementary level.

At the middle school level appropriate learning activities for academically talented students may include but not be limited to accelerated classes and accelerated classroom instruction.

At the high school level appropriate learning activities for academically talented students may include but not be limited to college credit bearing courses, advanced placement courses, distance learning courses, honors level courses, accelerated classroom instruction and school-to-work experiences.

In-service training in enrichment programs shall be provided to instructional staff as needed.

As necessary, the Superintendent of Schools shall develop and implement rules, regulations and procedures that advance the Board's commitment to the creation of enrichment opportunities for students.
