

**DISTRIBUTION OF INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PLANS (IEP's) TO
ENSURE IMPLEMENTATION**

The chairperson of the Committee on Special Education (CSE) shall ensure that each regular education teacher, special education teacher, related service provider, assistant, aide and any other service provider whether a staff member, sub-contractor, independent contractor or consultant who is responsible for the implementation of a student's individualized education program (IEP) shall be given a copy of such student's IEP prior to the implementation of the student's special education program.

Any copy of a student's IEP provided pursuant to this policy shall remain confidential and shall not be re-disclosed to any other person except in compliance with applicable federal and State laws and regulations.

The chairperson of the CSE shall designate a professional employee of the school district with knowledge of the student's disability and education program to, prior to the implementation of the IEP, inform each regular education teacher, special education teacher, related service provider, assistant, aide and any other service provider whether a staff member, sub-contractor, independent contractor or consultant of his or her responsibility relating to the implementation of the student's IEP and the specific accommodations, modifications, and support that must be provided for the student in accordance with the IEP.
