

TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education is cognizant of its responsibility for designating textbooks for use in the schools operated by the District. Such designations shall be based upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools. Textbooks recommended by the Superintendent shall be consistent with the curriculum established for the course of study.

Once designated by the Board, textbooks shall not be changed by the Board of Education within a period of five years, except by three-fourths vote of the Board of Education.

The Superintendent shall develop and implement such rules and procedures as are necessary for ensuring that the textbooks she/he recommends to the Board for adoption are those best suited to: the New York State Learning Standards and the educational philosophy of excellence of the Berlin Central School District.

The Board of Education shall loan textbooks to all students attending its schools. Students who are residents of the district and attend non-public or private school will also be loaned textbooks. Private and parochial school students shall make individual requests for those textbooks they require.
