

SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education encourages and supports the appropriate use of volunteers in the schools to strengthen the relationship between the schools and the community they serve. Volunteers provide an invaluable service to those carrying out the District's educational mission. The Board, the Superintendent of Schools, building principals, administrators and others so designated, may accept the services of volunteers on behalf of the District.

Volunteers in the District's schools, offices, and programs may come from all backgrounds and age groups, and may include anyone willing to donate her/his time for the purpose of helping or supporting the education of children through planned auxiliary services. District personnel who are responsible for tasks or projects that will seek the services of volunteers shall identify appropriate tasks and schedules for such activities. District personnel must make provision for supervision of volunteer activities, necessary training programs and the evaluation of volunteer assistance.

In the event the District does not provide transportation to a school sponsored program, activity or event, it shall be the responsibility of the person in parental relation to the student to provide transportation of the student to such program, activity or event. At no time shall volunteers be used by the district or district personnel to provide transportation to students for school-sponsored activities, programs, or events.
