

COMPLAINTS ABOUT SCHOOL PERSONNEL

The Berlin Central School District Board of Education shall respond to all complaints it receives about school personnel in a manner that balances the interests of the public with the individual rights of school district employees. Any such complaint received by a member or members of the Board, or by the Board as a whole, shall be referred to the Superintendent of Schools for investigation and review prior to any action that might be taken by the Board.

Any discussion of and any charges relating to the competence or personal conduct of any individual employed by or performing services in any capacity on behalf of the Berlin Central School District shall be deemed and shall be ruled out of order at public meetings of the Board.
