

PICKETING AND DEMONSTRATIONS

1. The Berlin Central School District Board of Education affirms that picketing and demonstrating on District property, as permitted by law, shall be subject to the following time, place, and manner restrictions.
 - A. Picketing and demonstrating shall at no time interfere with lawful entry to or egress from District property.
 - B. Picketing and demonstrating shall at no time interfere with the right of those not participating in such activities to obtain an education through their participation in the instructional, support, and related programs and activities operated or sponsored by the District.
2. The Board further establishes that a person who is not involved in picketing or demonstrating shall not interfere with the right of others to peacefully and lawfully picket or demonstrate on District property.
3. A violation of any prohibition set forth in this policy shall be dealt with as a disciplinary matter where the perpetrator is a student or employee of the District. The Superintendent or her/his designee shall report any such violation to appropriate law enforcement authorities if, in the judgment of authorized District personnel, such a report is required in consideration of the facts and circumstances surrounding the incident. The District shall cooperate with these authorities in investigating such incidents and, when necessary, prosecuting those responsible.
